CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In July:

- Approved the Interlocal Agreement for Fire Protection Services with Hyrum City Corporation for fiscal year 2010-11.
- Approved a revision to the Water Service Guidelines to clarify information on water connections, penalties, and standby fees.
- Approved the Impact Fee Report identifying the projects to be used with impact fees collected.
- Reviewed the site for the new park pavilion to be constructed on the north end of the City Park.
- Discussed a request for abatement of utilities for active servicemen.
- Reviewed preparations for the Night Out Against Crime which was held on August 4.
- Discussed offering a CPR Training class for those interested.

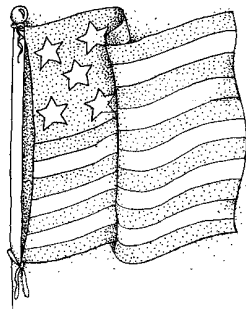
