CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In November:

- Discussed a request for an additional crossing guard on the corner on 100 South Main with Millville School personnel
- Approved a minor subdivision establishing Mathews Estates at approximately 460 North Main
- Reviewed the sign ordinance and a request for enforcement
- Canvassed the 2009 Municipal Election. The results were: For Mayor – Guy Curtis, 95; Michael E. Johnson, 243. For Councilmembers – Sheryl Hair, 301; Deborah Redman, 287.
- Cancelled the City Council Meeting scheduled for Thursday, November 26, as it is Thanksgiving Day.
- Reviewed business licenses issued during 2009. Renewal licenses for 2010 will be sent.
- Approved the purchase of a plaque for the North Park referencing the RAPZ Grant Funding.
- Approved an application form for Apartments in owner-occupied, single-family dwellings.
- Discussed possible projects for the remaining \$35,000 of the bonding money from the 2006 water project.

2010 DOG LICENSES

2010 Dog Licenses are here so you can get your dog licensed now! Up to 3 dogs that have been spayed/neutered \$7 each. If not spayed/neutered \$18 each. If you have 4-6 dogs you will need a kennel license \$120 total. The limit in Millville City is 6 dogs per household. Please send: money, proof of rabies, proof of spay/neut to Millville City, P.O. CHANGE IN DATES FOR CITY MEETINGS

The City Council of Millville City will conduct regular meetings on the second and fourth Thursdays of each month with meetings beginning at 7 p.m. The Planning Commission will meet on the first Thursday and third Thursday (as needed) of each month with meetings beginning at 8 p.m. The Appeal Authority will meet as needed. All meetings will be held at the City Office, 510 East 300 South, Millville, City, Utah, unless otherwise advertised. If the meeting date is on a legal holiday, the meeting shall be either canceled or rescheduled.
