CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In December:



- Canceled the City Council Meeting to be held on December 24, 2009, because of the holiday.
- Appointed Deb Low and Kerri Williams as the Youth Council Advisors. The Youth Council for the upcoming year will be as follows: Savanna Cummings, Mayor; Katie Pehrson, Recorder; Lauren Tibbitts, Treasurer; Councilmembers – Paul Hart, Meagan Williams, Paul Hair, Meghan Tibbitts, Bailey Zollinger, Katie Harvey, Katie Fitzgerald, and Tara Amberson.
- Discussed a request for an additional crossing guard on the corner of 100 South Main with Millville School personnel. At this time, there will be no additional crossing guard hired; however, there will be increased patrolling by the Sheriff's Department during the afternoon.
- Awarded the leasing of 3½ shares of water in the Millville Irrigation Company according to submitted sealed bids.
- Approved a Resolution Adopting the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan: Bear River Region, Utah as Required by the Federal Disaster Mitigation and Cost Reduction Act of 2000.
- Reviewed proposed revisions to Signage Ordinance 17.44, *Millville City Code*, as presented by the Planning Commission. Set a public hearing to receive public input on these revisions for January 14, 2010, at 7:30 p.m.
- Accepted the audit report for fiscal year 2009 as presented by Scott Swensen from Jones

Simkins.

- Set the calendar of events for the 2010 year. (See additional information in newsletter)
- Set annual meeting schedule for 2010. (See additional information in newsletter)
- Discussed rescinding the OHV ordinance because of safety concerns.
- Discussed a proposal for an individual to purchase property owned by the City at approximately 550 East 600 South; the request was denied.

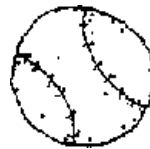
