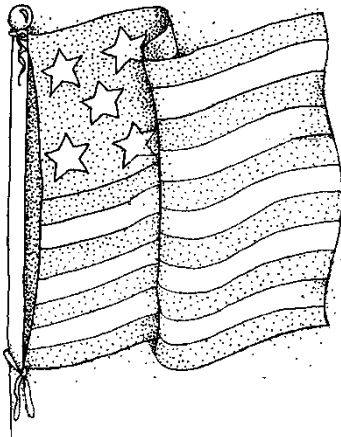

## CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In June:

- Approved a business license for Professional Digital Services, Inc. at 208 North Main as requested by Susan Barker.
- Approved a Youth Service Project to paint the city fire hydrants.
- Approved a resolution increasing the base rate on water connections by \$1 per month.
- Approved a resolution setting the Policy for Citing Owners of Unlicensed Dogs.
- Discussed a revision of the Signage Ordinance 17.44 and held a public hearing. The ordinance has not yet been adopted.
- Held an executive session for the purpose of discussing land acquisition.
- Approved a temporary permit to allow dual occupancy in a home at 465 North 250 East for a period of one year.
- Discussed an ordinance 17.08 regarding Owner-Occupied Homes with Apartments. This will be reviewed by the Planning Commission.
- Cancelled the July 2 City Council Meeting because of the holiday.
- Held public hearings on budgets and ordinances as noticed.
- Approved the revised budget for fiscal year 2008-2009.
- Approved the certified tax rate on property tax at .000632, down from last year which was .000651.
- Approved the budget for fiscal year 2009-2010.
- Approved a revision to ordinance Chapter 17.40 Landscaping and Fencing.



## TO ALL MILLVILLE CITY RESIDENTS

On the 18<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 the city council passed an amendment to the existing "Landscaping and Fencing Ordinance" requiring that any development within the city **after** the adoptions of this amendment, **landscape the city right-of-way adjacent** to the property being developed. The amendment is intended to assist in the overall beautification of Millville. As the amendment is not retroactive to current residents, there is no requirement for you to landscape this area. However, if any residents would like to landscape this area, the amendment identifies what can be done.

The city encourages all residents to maintain the city right-of-way adjacent to their property by mowing weeds and grasses to help prevent fires and beautify the city.

The city currently mows the city right-of-ways that can be accessed when they have the time. The city currently employs two people to perform all city infrastructure maintenance. Mowing is a low priority item based upon all infrastructure maintenance required. We can take pride in Millville's appearance by assisting in maintaining the city right-of-ways.
