2010 DOG LICENSES

2010 Dog Licenses are here so you can get your dog licensed now! Up to 3 dogs that have been spayed/neutered \$7 each. If not spayed/neutered \$18 each. If you have 4-6 dogs you will need a kennel license \$120 total. The limit in Millville City is 6 dogs per household. Please send: money, proof of rabies, proof of spay/neut to Millville City, P.O. WATER SHARES FOR LEASE

Millville City has 3 ³/₄ shares of water in the Millville Irrigation Company available for lease for a four-year period. The City Council will be accepting bids to use these shares requiring a \$30 minimum for one share or a \$15 minimum for one-half share. In addition, any administrative costs required by the canal company will also be required to be paid by the individual awarded the bid. The bids must be submitted and received no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, December 4, 2009. The bids will be reviewed and awarded at the City Council Meeting on December 10, 2009.
