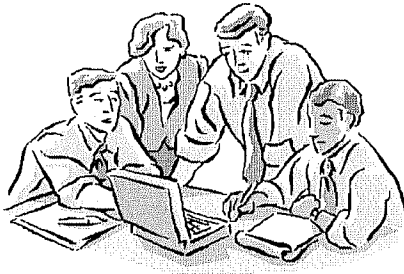

December Meetings:

December 8, 2016

Approved an Ordinance to Rezone Property Parcel 03-036-0009 from Agriculture to a Residential-1 Zone. Also approved the new zoning map for the City.

Reviewed bids submitted to rent water shares from the City; accepted the bids submitted.

Discussed and approved the Ridgeline Trail Agreement between Millville City and Nibley City.

Reviewed the annual audit report for Fiscal Year 2016 as presented by Mike Kidman, Jones Simkins. The audit report is available for review at the City Office.

Set a public hearing for January 12, at 7:15 p.m. to review revisions to the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget.

Discussed an updated version for the City Purchasing Policy. This will be reviewed at the next Council meeting.

Approved the Intercity Waste Water Agreement with Nibley City.

Approved the dates for the 2017 Meeting Schedule – City Council meets on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays' of the month beginning at 7:00 p.m. and the Planning Commission meets on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays' of the month beginning at 8:00 p.m. The meetings may be cancelled or rescheduled if they fall on a holiday.

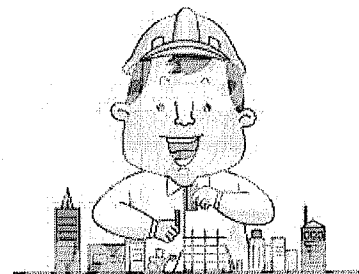

A dog clinic will be held on the following dates at the Millville City Offices, 310 South 500 East:

Saturday, February 4, 2017

(9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.) A veterinarian will be available for shots at a cost of \$16.00 each.

Saturday, February 18, 2017

(9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.)

Wednesday, February 22, 2017

(6:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.)

Licenses only will be issued, no shots.

Fees are as follows:

\$10.00/spayed or neutered

\$20.00/not spayed or neutered

\$150.00/kennel license, 4 to 6 dogs

You do not have to wait for the dog clinic dates to get your dog licensed. If your dog has a up to date rabies shot, with documentation, please contact Harry Meadows, 881-2977.
