Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In December:

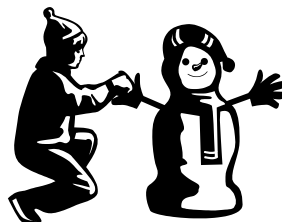
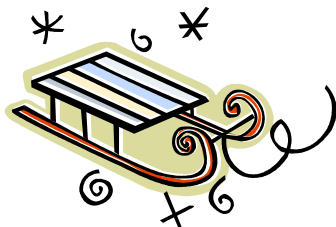
- Approved participating in the program Play Unplugged. It is to encourage children to do other activities instead of being plugged to electronic devices and television.
- Cancelled the City Council Meeting to be held on Thursday, December 26, 2013.
- Heard a report from the Youth Council regarding their fundraiser breakfasts. They were able to meet their goal for funding to go to the USU Youth Council Conference. Thanks for all of the community support!
- Approved a business license for EnergyWise Solutions LLC at 1000 West 1000 North, Building 29, Suite 111, owner Bruce Amberson.
- Approved bids for leasing of water shares to Robert Carpenter, Michael Callahan and Mike and Dawnette Hunter.
- Received and accepted the annual audit report for fiscal year 2013 as presented by Jones Simkins.
- Approved the following dates for events in 2014—Easter, Saturday April 19; Miss Millville, April 26; Old Mill Days, June 14; Night Out Against Crime, August 13; Christmas, December 6.
- Approved the annual meeting notice for 2014 as follows: City Council Meetings held on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays of each month beginning at 7 p.m.; Planning Commission Meetings held on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays beginning at 8 p.m.; Appeal Authority to meet as needed. 2014 DOG LICENSES

The 2014 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2014. Fees double after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326 or drop it in the utility payment drop box at the city office. Up to three dogs, \$10 each if spayed/neutered and \$20 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$150. Six dogs is the limit! The Dog Clinic is scheduled for Saturday, February 1, 2014 from 9am-11am. Please see enclosed flyer!
