**CITY COUNCIL CORNER**

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In December:

- Reviewed the draft of the City Master Plan. Watch for more information and hearings to be held by the Planning Commission and City Council.
- Set the annual meeting schedule for 2015 as follows: City Council – 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday beginning at 7 p.m.; Planning Commission – 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday at 8 p.m. and 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday (as needed); Appeal Authority – as needed.
- Heard a report on the Youth Council activities by Kennady Zollinger: October, did service by picking up garbage along the roadways; November, volunteered at the food pantry where they separated food; December, held their fundraiser along with the Christmas festivities where Santa visited Millville.
- Approved a business license for the Smooth Shop at 1000 West 1000 North, Building 8, in the Zollinger Complex as requested by Kory Pence.
- Approved a business license for Jack R. Gage Refrigeration (JRG) at 1000 N 1000 W #104, Building 29, in the Zollinger Complex as requested by Matt Anderson.
- Reviewed bids received for leasing water irrigation shares owned by the City. There were still some remaining shares; the Council set the price at \$175 per share annually for one share and \$100 for one-half share and will be leased on a first-come basis.
- Cancelled the City Council Meeting to be held on December 25, 2015, as it is Christmas Day.
- Approved the final audit report for 2014 prepared by Jones Simkins.
- Did not approve a resolution encouraging the State of Utah to address Comprehensive Transportation Funding.
- Did not approved an agreement for Professional Services between Millville City and the Salt Lake City Chamber of Commerce regarding the Utah Transportation Coalition.
- Approved a project to paint and replace the carpet in the City Office.
- Discussed a draft ordinance regarding water rights.
- Reviewed a proposal regarding Millville City Sewer and a proposed ordinance regarding sewer usage.
- Held an executive session for the purpose of discussing land acquisition.

The 2015 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2015. Fees double after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$10 each if spayed/neutered and \$20 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$150. Six dogs is the limit!
