Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In January:

- The Oath of Office was given to the Youth Council who will be representing our city during this coming year. Certificates were given those Youth Councilmembers who had served during the past year. Special appreciation was expressed to Kerri Williams and Deb Low for serving as Youth Council Advisors during the past year as well.
- A business license was approved for Birch Creek Custom Woodworks at 115 North 250 East as requested by Dustin Ayotte.
- A business license was approved for YESCO Electronics, LLC as requested by Rodney D. Wardle. The business is located at approximately 1000 North 1000 West in the Zollinger Commercial Warehousing.

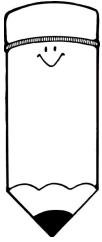
## POSTING PLACES FOR INFORMATION

The 2011 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2011. Fees double after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$7 each if spayed/neutered and \$18 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$120. Six dogs is the limit! ## NIBLEY-MILLVILLE FIRST RESPONDERS/SQUAD 140 REPORT

During 2010, Millville and Nibley cities experienced 96 medical emergencies within their boundaries. This was another all time high eclipsing the 2008 total of 75 and 2009 record of 92. Of those 96 medical emergencies, 31 occurred in Millville. Our Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) live in the Millville and Nibley areas and form the first level of response to medical emergencies. We are currently recruiting new members who would be willing to serve their communities by providing volunteer pre-hospital emergency care. Applicants must hold a current EMT Basic (or Intermediate/Paramedic) certificate from the Utah Bureau of Emergency Medical Services OR be willing to attend and successfully complete an EMT Basic course in Utah.
