Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In January:

- Appointed Michael Callahan to serve on the City Council, replacing Mark Thacker, for a two-year term.
- Reappointed Rose Mary Jones as the City Recorder and Tara Hobbs as the City Treasurer.
- Approved a business license for The Whitney Connection LLC at 1000 North 1000 West, Suite 108 as requested by Nathan Peterson.
- Approved a business license for Quik Check Financial Inc. at 1000 North 1000 West, Suite 108 as requested by Nathan Peterson.
- Discussed roadways for the eastern access for the new high school.
- Accepted the resignation of Jonathan Thacker as a Planning Commission Alternate.
- Discussed the traffic signs on the corner of 350 North 300 East.
- Appointed Natalie Smith to serve as an alternate on the Planning Commission.
- Reviewed the Quarterly Financial Reports for the 2nd Quarter of fiscal year 2014, finding all in line with the projected budget amounts.

DATES TO REMEMBER

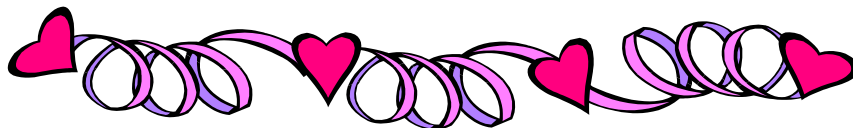

2014 DOG LICENSES

The 2014 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2014. Fees double after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326 or drop it in the utility payment drop box at the city office. Up to three dogs, \$10 each if spayed/neutered and \$20 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$150. Six dogs is the limit! COUNCIL MEMBER MESSAGE

Last year Millville City made the decision to participate in the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program. In the fall we sponsored a class at the city office and we were thrilled with the interest we had from the members of our community. I love that we live in a community filled with people who have an interest in being prepared and ready to help their neighbors.

The **Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)** Program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using the training learned in the classroom and during exercises, CERT members can assist others in their neighborhood or workplace following an event when professional responders are not immediately available to help. CERT members also are encouraged to support emergency response agencies by taking a more active role in emergency preparedness projects in their community.

We had such a great response to our first class that the city would like to provide the opportunity again for our residents to become CERT certified. The class will begin on Thursday March 6th from 6:30-9:30 and will be held weekly through May 3rd (there will be no class the week of spring break). The class will be held at the sheriff's office complex in Logan. The cost of the class is \$50. The city will reimburse the \$50 to any Millville resident who completes the class and becomes CERT certified. This is a wonderful opportunity to become even more educated on handling emergencies.
