CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In January:

- Oath of Office was given to Councilmembers Michael Callahan, Cindy Cummings, and Mark Williams to begin their new term of office.
- Recorder Rose Mary Jones and Treasurer Tara Hobbs were reappointed to their respective positions.
- Reappointed Patricia Cronin to serve on the Cache Valley Transit District Board to represent Millville City.
- Approved a business license for Craft Contractors LLC in the Zollinger Complex.
- Approved a business license for CrossFit Antietam in the Zollinger Complex.
- Discussed information on updated impact fees for roads, park, and water.
- Reviewed updated maps for the general plan draft.
- Discussed grant applications from the CMPO and TAP for funding of new sidewalks.
- Reviewed lighting and landscaping for the 450 North Main roundabout.
- Mayor Johnson reviewed Councilmember Assignments for the 2016 year.
- Reviewed and accepted bids to lease water shares for the next two years.
- Had a presentation on Management Hazards in Millville from a team of local and state consultants.
- Approved an Interlocal Agreement between Cache County School District and the City.
- Reviewed the quarterly financial reports for the 2nd quarter of fiscal year 2016.
- Discussed upcoming water projects and approved: the park pump upgrade with source protection delineation; proceeding to have the City's shares in the Garr Spring Irrigation Company changed to municipal use; maintenance on the booster pump for the water system; installation of a water line on 450/550 North to allow for continual flow; and authorized to proceed with the permitting process for the Glen Ridge well Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) project.

2016 DOG LICENSES

The 2016 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2016. Fees **double** after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$10 each if spayed/neutered and \$20 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$150. Six dogs is the limit! **Dog licenses will be issued at the City Office building Saturday, February 20th from 9am-11am and Wednesday, February 24th from 6pm-8pm.** If you have any questions regarding dog licenses please leave a message for Stephanie at 750-0924.
