**CITY COUNCIL CORNER**

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In February:

- Reviewed recommendations for the new Millville High School as follows: west facing school; access from 550 North (2300 south); stop light on 2300 South, Highway 165; multiple accesses from the east—1<sup>st</sup> choice, 100 North, 2<sup>nd</sup> choice, 300 North, with 200 North as a service entrance only, not to be used by students.
- Heard comments regarding the proposed high school from city residents and property owners.
- Approved a business license for Keetz, a hair salon, as requested by Nikeeta Larsen at 295 North 100 East.
- Approved a business license at 320 North 200 East from Daisylane Sweet Shoppe, for sewing baby items, as requested by Lynnette Haltiner.
- Reappointed Bonnie Farmer to serve as a Planning Commissioner.
- Accepted the proposal from J-U-B for updating the City General Plan.
- Discussed different options to be submitted for RAPZ grant funds.
- Canceled the Council Meeting to be held on February 28 because of training for Councilmembers.

**CITY ACTIVITIES FOR 2013**

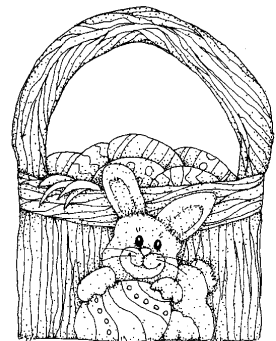

## 2013 DOG LICENSES

Dog licenses were due by March 1<sup>st</sup>. Fees are now double. Please get your dog licensed as soon as possible to avoid receiving a citation from Animal Control. The prices for a dog license are as follows: If you have 1-3 dogs \$20 each for a spayed/neutered dog or \$40 each for a non-spayed/neutered dog. If you have 4-6 dogs \$300 for a kennel license. You can mail your proof of rabies and spay/neuter with a check to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. A dog license and your paperwork will be mailed back to you.
