### **CITY COUNCIL CORNER**

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In February:

- Set a public hearing on the draft for the General Plan to be on March 12, 2015 at 7:20 p.m.
- Held a public hearing for proposed revisions to the City Budget in the general fund.
- Approved the revised 2015 City Budget.
- Discussed a proposal for the RAPZ Grant application requesting funding to have restroom facilities built near the splash pad at the City Park.
- Heard a presentation on Smart Growth for Cache Valley as presented by Jake Young.
- Discussed the City Election process. The municipal election will be held on November 3, 2015 at the City Office. Millville City will not be using the vote by mail process in the upcoming election.
- The NRCS River Project was completed and closed. The funding from the federal grant was a 75% to 25% match. Millville City expended approximately \$40,000 on the project.
- Millville City has purchased property at 465 North Main with the intent of building a roadway to connect 450 North to 550 North.
- Heard a presentation on Mobility and Transportation from Allison Richman representing Bear River Association of Governments.
- Considered a rezone request from Martha Balph with a recommendation from the Planning Commission on parcels 03-37-0019, 03-37-0020 and 03-37-0055. The rezone would have the property go from Open Space to Residential-1.
- The Council briefly discussed an Interlocal Agreement with Cache County School District. This will be discussed at greater length at future meetings.
- Approved Ordinance 2015-1 a Revision to the Fencing Ordinance 17.40.050.

### **2015 DOG LICENSES – FEES NOW DOUBLE**

Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. The double fees are: Up to three dogs, \$20 each if spayed/neutered and \$40 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$300. Six dogs is the limit! ## **MILLVILLE CITY NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL OFFICES TO BE VOTED ON**

Millville City will hold a municipal election on November 3, 2015. There are three council seats for four-year terms that will be voted on. The councilmembers whose term of office will expire are: Michael Callahan, Cindy Cummings, and Mark Williams. The filing period will begin on June 1, 2015 and will conclude on June 8, 2015 at 5 p.m.

As outlined in the Utah State Code, the following outlines the eligibility requirements for those interested in declaring candidacy:

20A-9-203. Declarations of candidacy -- Municipal general elections.

(1) (a) (i) A person may become a candidate for any municipal office if:

(A) the person is a registered voter; and

(B) (I) the person has resided within the municipality in which that person seeks to hold elective office for the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election; or

(II) if the territory in which the person resides was annexed into the municipality, the person has resided within the annexed territory or the municipality the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election.

(ii) For purposes of determining whether a person meets the residency requirement of Subsection (1)(a)(i)(B)(I) in a municipality that was incorporated less than 12 months before the election, the municipality shall be considered to have been incorporated 12 months before the date of the election.

(b) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (1)(a), each candidate for a municipal council position shall, if elected from a district, be a resident of the council district from which elected.

(c) In accordance with Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored under Section 20A-2-101.3 or 20A-2-101.5.
