CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In February:

- Approved Sign Applications for Ridgeline High School requested by Principal Bob Henke.
- Approved a business license for Amber Sleight at 220 North 300 East for a business called 'I'd Rather Be Sewing'.
- Discussed and clarified information regarding the Impact Fee Analysis for Roads, Parks, and Water Fees as well as the General Plan and Parks and Trails Plan.
- Awarded the bid for the 450/550 North Road Project to Johnson Construction Company.
- Discussed the elementary school safety needs for pedestrian walkways.
- Reviewed with the Millville-Nibley Cemetery Board their proposal for expansion of the cemetery property.
- Approved a Resolution Establishing the Park Capital Improvement Plan.
- Approved the RAPZ Grant Application for 2016 requesting funding for a restroom facility near the splash pad at the City Park.
- Approved the printing for an Emergency Management Pamphlet to be delivered to all residents in the community.
- Reviewed the Water System Audit for 2015 showing 96.32 million gallons were sold in the community during the months of April through September.
- Discussed the business application process with the Council continuing to seek clarification for businesses to be licensed.

2016 DOG LICENSES

The 2016 Dog License fees are now double. The deadline for licensing your dog was March 1, 2016. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$20 each if spayed/neutered and \$40 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$300. Six dogs is the limit! **If your dog is not licensed by April 1, 2016 you may be subject to a citation from the Cache County Sheriff's Office Animal Control Officer.** If you have any questions regarding dog licenses please leave a message for Stephanie at 750-0924.

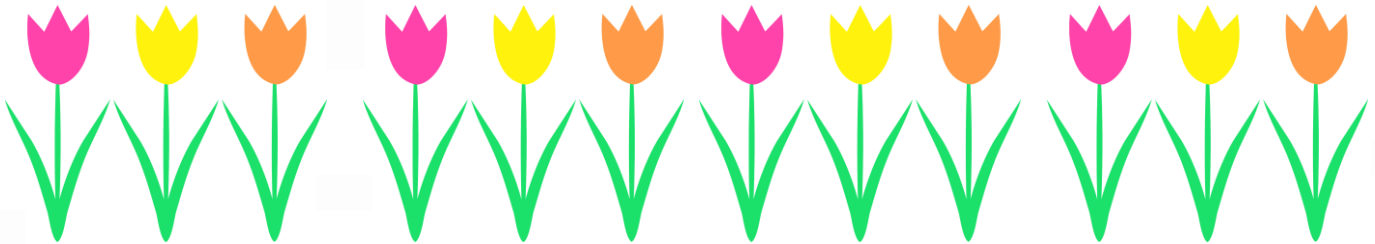
