

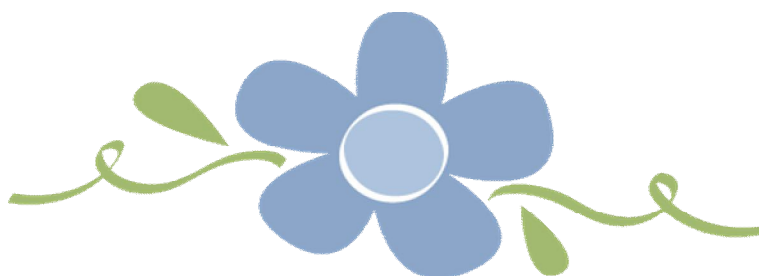

CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In March:

- Approved a business license for Gabsynthetics at 150 East Center as requested by Gabe Gonzalez.
- Approved a business license for ZBROZ Racing LLC, 1000 West 1000 North, requested by Ryan Zollinger.
- Heard a presentation from the Child and Family Support Center and supported a declaration for April as Child Abuse Prevention Month.
- Heard a report on the 2012 year for the Cache Valley Transit District. Ridership grew by 1.8% on fixed routes and averaged 29.75 passengers on every bus for every hour of service provided.
- Set a public hearing for April 11, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. to obtain comment on a rezone request for parcels 03-036-0002 and 03-036-0015 (Knowles/Mathews property) changing from an agricultural (A) zone to residential (R-1).
- Discussed the updating of the City General Plan and reviewed the scope of work. Authorized applying for a grant in the amount of \$65,000 with the CIB; this is a 50% match grant.
- Heard a proposal regarding the Utah Geological Survey for Aquifer Storage and Recovery. The Glen Ridge well is being considered to be used in this study. The Council approved participating.
- The 2012 Water Audit was provided to the Council by Superintendent Gary Larsen.
- Purchased five mini shelters as part of the RAPZ Grant approved in 2012.
- Heard a report on a meeting held with the Cache County School District where recommendations were presented.
- Approved a Financial Ready Resolution which would instigate research to find out all areas where federal dollars are being spent.
- Discussed a project by CenturyLink on Main Street where new fiber optic cable is being installed.
- Approved a business license for Salon Solace at 15 East 300 South as requested by Pam Waldron.
- Approved a business license for Lyndale Marketing Inc. at 1000 West 1000 North Building 29, Suite 101 as requested by John Slater.
- Approved a business license for Rocky Mountain Technology Services Inc. at 1000 West 1000 North Building 29, Suite 101 as requested by John Slater.
- Discussed information for the fiscal year 2014 budget.

CITIZENS EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM- CERT:

Cache County CERT is offering a certification class to train citizens how to correctly respond in the event of a disaster. The cost is \$50.00. MILLVILLE CITY WILL REIMBURSE THE \$50 REGISTRATION FEE AT THE END OF THE COURSE FOR ANY MILLVILLE CITIZEN WHO IS INTERESTED IN PARTICIPATING IN THE CERT COURSE.

This is an eight week course and will be held one night a week for 3 hours. The registration fee includes a backpack, CERT vest, utility helmet, manual and identification badge. Students are instructed by professionals, with "hands on" application of disaster preparedness and about how to respond in the event of an actual emergency in our own community.

The training topics consists of Disaster Preparedness, Fire Safety, Disaster Medical Operations, Light Search and Rescue Operations, CERT Organization, Disaster Psychology, Terrorism and CERT, and a Course Review and Disaster Simulation. The Disaster Simulation is at the County Fire training facility where students participate in a mock simulation of a disaster.

Millville needs citizens 18 years of age or older to volunteer to be trained so we can set up our own response team. If we have 20 people who are interested in taking the course, the county will come to Millville to provide the training. Please help us build a strong CERT program in Millville to benefit our community in case of a disaster.
