### CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In March:

- Reappointed Garrett Greenhalgh to serve as a Planning Commissioner for another term.
- Set a public hearing for April 28, 2016 to review the General Plan with the Public.
- Approved an Interlocal Agreement regarding Providence Sewer Lines within the Millville City limits.
- Approved a business license for Stellar Collision Repair at 380 North 200 East, as requested by Craig Nielson.
- Approved an additional expense to the Stormwater Fund for training to meet the new Stormwater requirements.
- Approved purchasing 100 Automated Water Meters from the water account.
- Reviewed the Impact Fee Analysis for Water, Transportation and Park Fees along with an Ordinance to Support the Proposed Analysis.

### 2016 DOG LICENSES

**The 2016 Dog License fees are now double.** The deadline for licensing your dog was March 1, 2016. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$20 each if spayed/neutered and \$40 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$300. Six dogs is the limit! **If your dog is not licensed by April 1, 2016 you may be subject to a citation from the Cache County Sheriff's Office Animal Control Officer.** If you have any questions regarding dog licenses please leave a message for Stephanie at 750-0924.

### PREVENT UNDERAGE DRINKING!

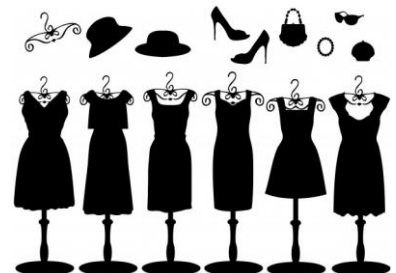
Sobering facts about underage drinking:

1. Parents must convey clear disapproval of underage drinking, because even a small amount of perceived parental acceptability can lead to substance use.
2. The younger a person starts to drink, the higher the risk of addiction.
