CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In April:

- Approved a business license for Lowry and Associates, Inc. at 10 West 300 South as requested by Todd R. Brown.
- Approved a business license for Paradise Fire Protection at 1000 North 1000 West Suite 100 as requested by John and Kris Blankman.
- Reviewed the annual building inspection report as presented by Cache County Building Inspector Brian Abbott.
- Reviewed suggested changes to the Millville City Code—Chapter 5, Business Licenses and Regulations; Chapter 9, Public Peace, Morals, and Welfare; and Chapter 17, Zoning. A public hearing was set for May 9 at 7:30 p.m. to receive input on these changes.
- Held a public hearing regarding a request from property owners Mondell Knowles and Larry and Charlene Mathews to rezone from agriculture to residential property parcels 03-036-0002 and 03-036-0015 located at approximately 400 East to 600 East and approximately 300 North to Center Street. The rezone request was granted.
- The election filing dates have been amended by the State Legislature. The candidate filing period of the municipal election will be from June 1, 2013 to June 7, 2013, at 5 p.m.
- The quarterly financial report for the third quarter of fiscal year 2013 was presented. The City is within the budgeted amounts and in good financial standing.
- Mayor Johnson presented to the Council the proposed City Budget for Fiscal Year 2014 to the Council.
- Heard a report on the Stormwater Festival held at the Cache County Fairgrounds where approximately fifty classes of 4th grade students attended.
- A report was made on a video inspection of the 300,000 gallon and the 1,000,000 gallon reservoirs. The reservoirs are sound and have very little sediment in them.
- The Miss Millville Pageant will be held on Thursday, May 23, at the Providence South Stake Center.

ELECTION NOTICE

Elections for the municipality of Millville, Utah will be held on November 5, 2013. Persons interested in becoming a candidate for a municipal office shall file a "Declaration of Candidacy" form in person with City Recorder Rose Mary Jones between June 1, 2013 and 5 p.m. on June 7, 2013. To complete this filing, please contact Rose Mary Jones at 435-752-8943 to arrange a time. This election will be for mayor and two council members – all four year terms. The qualifications of a candidate are: 1) Be a United States Citizen; 2) Be at least 18 years old; 3) Be a resident of the municipality or a resident of the recent annexed area for a period of 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of the election; 4) Be a registered voter of the municipality.

CITIZENS EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM- CERT:

Cache County CERT is offering a certification class to train citizens how to correctly respond in the event of a disaster. The cost is \$50.00. MILLVILLE CITY WILL REIMBURSE THE \$50 REGISTRATION FEE AT THE END OF THE COURSE FOR ANY MILLVILLE CITIZEN WHO IS INTERESTED IN PARTICIPATING IN THE CERT COURSE.

This is an eight week course and will be held one night a week for 3 hours. The registration fee includes a backpack, CERT vest, utility helmet, manual and identification badge. Students are instructed by professionals, with "hands on" application of disaster preparedness and about how to respond in the event of an actual emergency in our own community.

The training topics consists of Disaster Preparedness, Fire Safety, Disaster Medical Operations, Light Search and Rescue Operations, CERT Organization, Disaster Psychology, Terrorism and CERT, and a Course Review and Disaster Simulation. The Disaster Simulation is at the County Fire training facility where students participate in a mock simulation of a disaster.

Millville needs citizens 18 years of age or older to volunteer to be trained so we can set up our own response team. If we have 20 people who are interested in taking the course, the county will come to Millville to provide the training. Please help us build a strong CERT program in Millville to benefit our community in case of a disaster.
