CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month.

In April:

- Reappointed Rachel Thompson to serve of the Planning Commission for another term.
- Set a public hearing for May 8, 2014 at 7:20 p.m. to review a request from Cache County School District to construct a high school with associated athletic fields, parking lots, and roadways.
- Approved the Pehrson Place Subdivision on Parcel 03-037-0035 as requested by Doug and Luann Pehrson.
- Approved a business license for Chromoly Plus at 296 North 100 West as requested by Glenn Floyd.
- Discussed usage and preparation of the City Park baseball fields.
- Heard an update on the Nibley/Millville Emergency Medical Services. Last year there were 22 calls made, and the first quarter of this calendar year there have been five calls where they have been of assistance.
- Reviewed the City's third quarter financial reports.
- Approved a Forestry, Fire, and State Lands Facility and Land Use Agreement with the State of Utah; this would allow for firefighters to have use of the City Park as needed.
- Reviewed some preliminary findings of the Master Plan survey.

BURN PERMITS

The burn permits are available from March 28 through May 31 depending on the clearing index. The permits are being issued by the Utah Division of Air Quality. Permits are required for all burning.
