CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In April:

- Approved a business license For the Dog LLC requested by Amy Eskelsen at 35 East 300 South.
- Adopted an ordinance approving the rezone of property parcels – 03-037-0019, 03-037-0020, and 03-037-0055 from open space to residential as requested by Martha Balph.
- Approved the Law Enforcement and the Animal Control Contracts for fiscal year 2016.
- Approved participation with the irrigation company and school district for installing a storm water drain line from the lower canal on 100 North westward; also approved an extension of the sewer line from the canal on 200 North 100 West excluding any laterals to the property.
- Reviewed all businesses which are currently licensed within the City.
- Heard a report on Youth Council activities for the past few months presented by Tori Nyman.
- Reviewed a report regarding the Cache Valley Transit District 2014 Performance.
- Approved a business license for Little Explorers Academy Preschool at 370 North 300 East as requested by Crystal Jensen.
- A presentation was made to the Council regarding a proposed water conservancy district for Cache County.
- Approved a business license for G & E Wholesales Produce in the Zollinger Complex, 1000 North 1000 West, building 28, Suite 108.
- Heard a proposal regarding a form-based code, which could outline commercial designs for the City.
- Reviewed and discussed the interlocal agreement between the City and Cache County School District regarding the new high school.
- Reviewed the City Financial Report for the 3rd quarter of fiscal year 2015.

NEW RESIDENTIAL OPEN BURNING REGULATIONS

Burn Permit Information – March 30th to May 30th

Open burning is a source of air pollution that is regulated by the Utah Division of Air Quality (DAQ). There are statewide rules in place that regulate open burning activities. Recent modifications to these rules change the open burn periods and include a statewide requirement to obtain a DAQ Online Open Burn Permit Application prior to burning.
