CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month.

In April:

- Approved the renewal of the Law Enforcement and Animal Control Contracts for Fiscal Year 2017. A report was made by Sheriff Chad Jensen on the activities of the department for the last year.
- Held public hearings on the Revised General Plan for Millville City and also an Ordinance Revising Impact Fees for Culinary Water, Transportation, and Parks.
- Approved the Revision of the General Plan with minor corrections to be made.
- Approved the Ordinance for Millville City Impact Fees with Supporting Documentation.
- Approved a Resolution to Initiate the Creation of the Cache Water District as sponsored by Cache County. A public hearing was set for May 26, 2016 at 7:15 p.m. during the regular Millville City Council Meeting to receive public input on this resolution.
- Approved the Tibbitts Subdivision (4 lots) located on 550 North from Main Street to approximately 100 West with the condition of the adoption of the Roadway Dedication Map.
- Reviewed an annexation petition for 20 acres of property (Parcel 03-036-0009) as requested by Doran J. and Kathy R. Baker Trs. located at approximately Center Street and 550 East in Millville. This was not accepted until further information could be provided.

2016 DOG LICENSES

The 2016 Dog License fees are now double. The deadline for licensing your dog was March 1, 2016. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$20 each if spayed/neutered and \$40 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$300. Six dogs is the limit! **If your dog is not licensed by April 1, 2016 you may be subject to a citation from the Cache County Sheriff's Office Animal Control Officer.** If you have any questions regarding dog licenses please leave a message for Stephanie at 750-0924.
