CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In May:

- Reviewed the budget for fiscal year 2014 and set a public hearing for June 13, 2013 at 7:15 p.m.
- Approved the bid for Ideal Grounds for lawn care on the North Park during the summer months.
- Held a public hearing with regard to revisions to the Millville City Code—Chapters 5, 9 and 17. The recommended changes were approved in ordinance 2013-2. Link to Sterling Codifiers for code: http://www.sterlingcodifiers.com/codebook/index.php?book_id=407
- Discussed the Cache County Water Master Plan. As Millville is part of this plan, approved a resolution in Support of Pursuing an Aquifer Water and Storage Study for the Glen Ridge Well.
- Approved a business license for Curb Appeal Garage Doors at 160 West 200 North as requested by Mark Bodily.
- Approved a business license for One Fire Day Decore at 105 South 200 West as requested by Theresa Anne Johnson.
- Held a public hearing considering approval of an application for financial assistance from the Community Impact Board to update the City's Master Plan and impact fees.
- Reviewed the Revision to Fiscal Year Budget 2012-13 and set a public hearing for June 13, 2013 at 7:15 p.m.
- Discussed the RAPZ Grant Funding received in the amount of \$40,000 which is to be used to build a splash pad. Details on placement and size are still being reviewed.
- Reviewed the details for Old Mill Day to be held on June 22.
- Discussed the CERT Training to be sponsored through the City. Please contact Councilmember Cindy Cummings for more details.
