CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In May:

- Discussed an Eagle Scout Project as proposed by Ryan Johnson to construct a "Welcome to Millville" sign by the south bridge.
- Discussed concerns regarding storm water runoff during the winter months with the Millville Irrigation Company representatives.
- Held a public hearing regarding a request by Cache County School District for a Conditional Use Permit to construct a new high school with associated athletic fields, parking lots and roadways at approximately 180 North 300 West; approved the Conditional Use Permit for the High School with an Interlocal Agreement being finalized.
- Reviewed the proposed budget for fiscal year 2015 and set a public hearing for June 12, 2014 at 7:30 p.m.
- Discussed the costs associated with monitoring storm water issues during construction.
- Received instruction on using the digital equipment purchased by the City.
- Heard a proposal for an increase in the tax rate of $\frac{1}{4}$ of 1% for the Cache Valley Transit. This is being considered to go on the ballot for the November election.
- Approved a business license for J & T Services at 25 West 300 South as property by Trevor Preece and Jesse Waite.
- Reviewed the revisions to the proposed fiscal year 2014 budget and set a public hearing for June 12, 2014 at 7:30 p.m.
- Discussed a revision to an ordinance regarding Chapter 10 – Vehicles and Traffic regarding speed limits.

2014 DOG LICENSES

LOGAN CITY POLICE 911 COMMUNICATIONS

On January 21, 2014 the Logan City Council approved Resolution No. 13-83 finalizing a county-wide emergency communication charge as part of the current refuse collection fee. The \$1 per refuse can increase will fund local radio communications and ensure continued support for the system currently used by all public safety responders in Cache County. We would like to remind you that the additional \$1 fee becomes effective July 2014, therefore you will see and increase on your bill.
