- Reviewed the proposed budget for the 2016 fiscal year.
- Discussed revisions for the 2015 fiscal year budget.
- Set a public hearing to review proposed budget information for fiscal years 2015 and 2016 on July 11 at 7:20 p.m. and to increase the salaries for elected officials.
- Approved a Resolution Policy for Utah Retirement Systems regarding Tier 2 Retirement.
- Had a presentation on the Cache County Water Master Plan and a proposed Water Conservancy District.
- Heard a proposal and discussed form-based codes.
- Discussed expanding businesses in residential zones.
- Reviewed information on private roads.
- Discussed a Millville City Sewer Conceptual Plan identifying the requirements for the high school to have sewer at this time.
- Reported on the City's negotiations regarding an Interlocal Agreement with the Cache County School District.
- Reviewed Election Candidacy filing dates which were from June 1, 2015 to June 8, 2015 at 5 p.m.
