CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month.

In May:

- Discussed the Cache Valley Transit District bus routes and other information as presented by Patricia Cronin, our Millville City Representative to the CVTD Board.
- Proposed an increase in the water rates at \$.05 per thousand gallons used.
- Proposed an increase in the Stormwater Fee from \$2 to \$3 per month to cover mandated expenses required for our City.
- Reviewed budget information for fiscal year 2016-17 and revisions to the budget for fiscal year 2015-16. A public hearing was set on the budgets for June 9, 2016 at 7:30 p.m.
- A presentation was made to the Council regarding Trail Systems by the County Trail Coordinator Dayton Crites.
- There was discussion regarding an agreement between Nibley City and Millville City for Sewer Usage, as the high school and seminary buildings will be on the sewer system. There was also discussion on a proposed sewer ordinance.
- A temporary ban was approved on fireworks for 2016 banning all aerial fireworks east of 500 East and no fireworks east of 550 East in the City. The Council will consider a request for a permanent ban of fireworks in this area as requested by residents.
- Approved a business license for Covenant Consulting Group, Inc. at 190 West 265 South as requested by Ross Bowen.
- Approved a business license for Vivint Solar Developer LLC for Door-to-Door Solicitation as submitted by Dan Black.
- Held a public hearing regarding the proposed Cache Water District.
- Approved an Eagle Scout Project for a sign at 550 North 500 West as presented by Seth Duffin, with the condition of conforming with the City's sign ordinance.
- Approved an Interlocal Agreement with Cache County School District for the Ridgeline High School development.
