Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In June:

- Enjoyed a report presented by Brooke Nichols regarding the Youth Council and their activities.
- Approved a business license for SHX at 1000 West 1000 North, Building 29, Suites 106-107 as requested by Jeremy and Karen Higley and Brian Smith,
- Held a public hearing regarding budgeting for the City for Fiscal Years 2013 and 2014.
- Heard a report presented by Chris Searle representing the Nibley-Millville Emergency Medical Services. They are in need of volunteers willing to be a part of Emergency Medical Services Squad 140.
- The certified tax rate for Millville City was approved to be .000673.
- The Council approved a resolution setting the compensation for appointed officials.
- The budget for fiscal year 2013 was revised and approved.
- The budget for fiscal year 2014 was approved.
- The municipal election candidates filing for candidacy are: For Mayor - Michael E. Johnson; and Councilmembers – Glenn Floyd, Julianne Duffin, Ryan Zollinger, Robert “Bob” Bates.
- The Council discussed the placement of the splash pad to be built with RAPZ Grant monies.
- A resolution was reviewed regarding an increase in the Emergency Communication Charge as Part of the Refuse Collection Fee.

CITIZENS EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM- CERT:

The CERT training class is scheduled to begin on September 18th at the city office. This is a 3 hour class and will be every Wednesday night through the end of October. Please call to sign up!

Cache County CERT is offering a certification class to train citizens how to correctly respond in the event of a disaster. The cost is \$50.00. **MILLVILLE CITY WILL REIMBURSE THE \$50 REGISTRATION FEE AT THE END OF THE COURSE FOR ANY MILLVILLE CITIZEN WHO IS INTERESTED IN PARTICIPATING IN THE CERT COURSE.**

This is an eight week course and will be held one night a week for 3 hours. The registration fee includes a backpack, CERT vest, utility helmet, manual and identification badge. Students are instructed by professionals, with "hands on" application of disaster preparedness and about how to respond in the event of an actual emergency in our own community.

The training topics consists of Disaster Preparedness, Fire Safety, Disaster Medical Operations, Light Search and Rescue Operations, CERT Organization, Disaster Psychology, Terrorism and CERT, and a Course Review and Disaster Simulation. The Disaster Simulation is at the County Fire training facility where students participate in a mock simulation of a disaster.

Millville needs citizens 18 years of age or older to volunteer to be trained so we can set up our own response team. If we have 20 people who are interested in taking the course, the county will come to Millville to provide the training. Please help us build a strong CERT program in Millville to benefit our community in case of a disaster.
