CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In June:

- Appointed Larry Lewis to serve on the Planning Commission as an alternate commissioner.
- Approved a business license for Melecio J. Hilera for Jacob's (tile and stone work business) at 278 North 100 East.
- Approved the Sheriff Contract for fiscal year 2015 for Law Enforcement and Animal Control Services.
- Reviewed a revision to Ordinance 10.04.030 regarding regulatory speed; posted streets. A public hearing will be held on this ordinance in the future.
- Denied having the Cache Valley Transit Tax Rate Increase put on the November ballot.
- Set the Certified Tax Rate for 2014-15 at .000643.
- Approved the 2015 Fiscal Year Budget.
- Approved a resolution to Set the Compensation of Appointed Officials.
- Approved a resolution adopting a revision to the 2014 fiscal year budget.
- Discussed water shares / fee in lieu of water share requirements.
- Heard an update on the Splash Pad project at the City Park.
- Placed restrictions on fireworks not allowing them above 500 East for the remainder of this year.
