- Adopted a resolution supporting an Increase in the Emergency Communication Charge as Part of the Refuse Collection Fee in the amount of \$1.00 per month.
- Approved a boundary line adjustment between Martha Balph and Millville City on property located at approximately 650 East 300 South
- Adopted a Proclamation for September 2013 as School Attendance Awareness Month in Millville City
- Approved Interlocal Agreements with Cache County for Law Enforcement and Animal Control Services
