

CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month.

In August:

- Approved a business license for Don's Quality Tile Inc. at 124 East 100 North as requested by Don Lewis.
- Discussed whether a conditional use permit would be needed for a building requested by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints at approximately 175 West 100 North; there will be no conditional use permit required.
- Appointed Bonnie Farmer to serve as a Planning Commissioner on the Millville City Planning Commission for another term.
- Considered information for a conditional use permit for a residential assisted living facility at approximately 305 East 450 as requested by Roger Roundy. This was returned to the Planning Commission for additional information on the development.
- Approved a business license for Katre's Books as requested by Katre Tamm for door to door solicitation selling books.
- Concluded the zoning ordinance as written should be maintained, which does not allow for private roads within the community.
- Discussed appointing legal counsel for the City, as Attorney Craig Carlston has taken on a position with another entity.
- Discussed landscaping on the roundabout near the new high school and also the proposed street light plans.
- Discussed an application being made to the CCCOG for a grant to fund and build additional roads.
- Reviewed a draft of the City Master Plan; this will be again reviewed and a public hearing on it will be forthcoming.
