Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In September:

- Oath of Office was given to the 2013-2014 Youth Councilmembers.
- Reviewed with Jordan Taylor an Eagle Scout Project proposal to make improvements on the Glen Ridge Well Protection Area / Glen Ridge Park.
- Approved a business license for Wayne Ruud, River Bottom Construction dba Invision Window/Doors at 96 North 100 West.
- Approved a business license for BAXBO, LLC at 1000 North 1000 West, Building 29, Suite 109 as requested by Shawn Baxter.
- Approved a business license for Randy B. Wall at 616 North 200 East for the business of In-depth Home Inspectors, Inc.
- Heard a presentation on Digital Integration for technological needs for the City now and in the future by Jeff Young of YTech.
- Discussed a temporary business license permit to help in expediting the processing of business licenses.

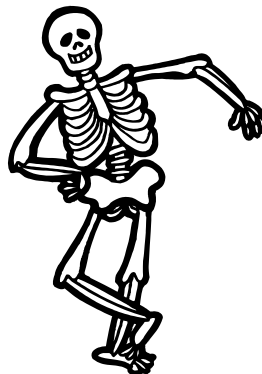

POSTING PLACES FOR INFORMATION

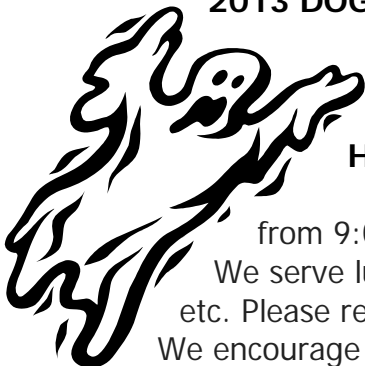
