CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month.

In September:

- Approved the Jason and Sherri Leishman Minor Subdivision at 150 East 100 South. The 1.5 acre parcel will be divided into two.
- Approved an agreement for Attorney Bruce Jorgensen to serve as the legal representation for Millville City.
- Discussed city-owned property west of the cemetery.
- Reviewed items regarding the new high school; safety sidewalk grant application for additional sidewalks for elementary and high school students; and a CCCOG grant application for a new roadway to be built connecting 450 North to 550 North.
- Heard presentations regarding Form-Based Codes.
- Discussed the rezone of property from open space to residential on 550 East as proposed by Neal Artz and Leanna Ballard.
- Approved having the 2015 Municipal Election cancelled with candidates to be declared elected to office.
