CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In October:

- Approved a Resolution to Allow a Provisional Business License for Millville City.
- Held a public hearing on revising the 2013-2014 City Budget; approved revisions.
- Approved a Resolution Approving and Entering into an Amended and Restated Agreement Creating the Utah Local Governments Trust.
- Discussed the need for a policy for the usage of parks.
- Reviewed the Quarterly Financial Reports for the first quarter of fiscal year 2014.
- Approved working with YTech for digital integration for Millville City materials.
- Approved installation of yield signs at the intersection of 350 North 300 East for the east/west bound traffic.
- Approved an agreement with J-U-B to update the City's Master Plan.
- Approved an agreement with Lewis Young Robertson and Burningham to update the City's Impact Fees.
- Received a donation of \$300 from Rocky Mountain Power for "Holiday Celebration" use.

There are 1100 registered voters in Millville City. There were 419 votes cast.

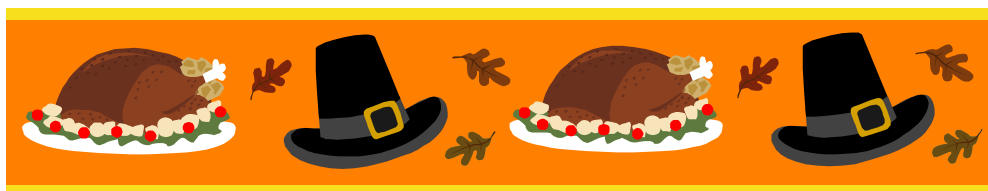
The Official Election Canvass is scheduled for November 14 during the City Council Meeting to be held at the City Office, 510 East 300 South, Millville.

MILLVILLE CITY WATER SHARES FOR LEASE BEGINNING NEXT YEAR

Millville City has three and one-half (3½) shares of water in the Millville Irrigation Company available for lease for a four-year period. The City Council will be accepting bids to use these shares requiring a \$30 minimum for one share or a \$15 minimum for one-half share. In addition, any administrative costs required by the canal companies will also be required to be paid by the individual awarded the bid. The bids must be submitted and received no later than 5 p.m. on December 6, 2013. The bids will be reviewed and awarded at the City Council Meeting on December 12, 2013. Those interested in bidding are to prepare a written bid and it should include: name, address and contact information; the dollar amount bid *per share*; the number of shares requested; the total for the bid; and the address of the parcel where the water will be used. 2014 DOG LICENSES

The 2014 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2014. Fees double after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326 or drop it in the utility payment drop box at the city office. Up to three dogs, \$10 each if spayed/neutered and \$20 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$150. Six dogs is the limit!
