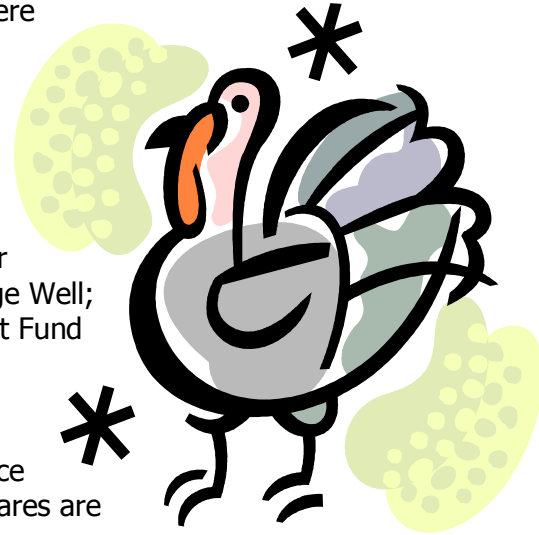

### **CITY COUNCIL CORNER**

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In October:

- Heard a report on the completed Eagle Project by Keaton Kleven where he cleaned the right of way on 200 South west toward the Maverik Station in Nibley.
- A presentation was made by David Dickey, Secretary of the Millville Nibley Cemetery District, requesting consideration for the Cemetery District to purchase property owned by the City which is west of the cemetery. There was no action taken on this to date.
- Approved a revision to the 2015 Fiscal Year Budget which allowed for funding for an Aquifer Storage and Recovery Project at the Glen Ridge Well; also a transfer of funding from the general fund to the Capital Project Fund for future projects.
- Approved a revision to Ordinance 10.04.030: Regulatory Speed changing the speed on residential streets from 30 mph to 25 mph.
- Approved the procedure for leasing of city-owned water shares. Notice of the requirements are posted in the posting boxes. Bids for the shares are due on December 5, 2014.
- Discussed the Interlocal Agreement for the Cache County School District and the Conditional Use Permit.
- Discussed information regarding Millville City sewer and the future of it.
- Reviewed the quarterly financial reports for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of fiscal year 2015.
- Approved the Memorandum of Understanding between Millville City and the Garr Spring Water Company, which would allow for a request to be made to the state to have the irrigation water shares owned by Millville City converted to a municipal use.
- Approved increasing the liability insurance for the City to \$5 million.

### **2015 DOG LICENSES**

The 2015 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2015. Fees double after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$10 each if spayed/neutered and \$20 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$150. Six dogs is the limit!
