CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In October:

- The Oath of Office was given to City Youth Council Members. There are approximately 40 members on our Youth Council this year. Brookelin Waldron is serving as Mayor, Josh Blankenship over Community Events, Sadie Anderson over Service and Cassie Wilker over Government Leadership for the first half of the year. For the latter half, Mayor will be Tori Nyman with Dixon Johnson over Community Events, Mikaeli Hill over Service, and Laci Leishman over Government Leadership.
- Approved the Comcast Franchise Agreement with Millville City for the upcoming 30 years.
- Reviewed the City Zoning Map.
- Heard a presentation on Impact Fees for Roads, Parks, and Water Services.
- Approved the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan as prepared by Bear River Association of Governments.
- Discussed renewals of business licenses for 2016.
- Reviewed the irrigation water shares which may be leased for a two-year period beginning 2016. (See more information in the newsletter)
- Discussed the budget for 2016 and revisions that need to be made.
- Approved an Interlocal Agreement/Conditional Use Permit with Cache County School District.

2016 DOG LICENSES

The 2016 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2016. Fees **double** after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$10 each if spayed/neutered and \$20 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$150. Six dogs is the limit! The dog clinic will be held on Saturday, February 6, 2016 from 9am-11am at the City Office building. MILLVILLE CITY WATER SHARES FOR LEASE BEGINNING NEXT YEAR

Millville City has eight (8) shares of water in the Millville Irrigation Company and four (4) shares of water available in the Providence Blacksmith Fork Irrigation Company available for lease for a two-year period. The City Council will be accepting bids to use these shares requiring a \$30 minimum for one share or a \$15 minimum for one-half share. In addition, any administrative costs required by the canal companies will also be required to be paid by the individual awarded the bid. The bids must be submitted and received no later than 5 p.m. on December 4, 2015. The bids will be reviewed and awarded at the City Council Meeting on December 10, 2015. Those interested in bidding are to prepare a written bid and it should include: name, address and contact information; the dollar amount bid *per share*; the number of shares requested; the total for the bid; and the address of the parcel where the water will be used (the land parcel must be able to be serviced by the irrigation company requested).
