CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In November:

- Approved a rezone for parcel 03-037-0054 owned by Neal Artz and parcel 03- 037-0015 and Clark and Leanna Ballard from Open Space to Residential-1.
- Had a presentation regarding communication options in case of an emergency.
- Approved having Civil Solutions Group develop a Form-Based Code.
- Reviewed the Quarterly Report for the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2016.
- Discussed revisions for the City Budget for Fiscal Year 2016; set a public hearing held on December 10, 2015.
- Approved the Impact Fee Report as required to be submitted to the Utah State Auditor.
- Canceled the City Council Meeting that was to be held on Thanksgiving Day.
- Approved an Ordinance Granting Questar Gas Company a Franchise for Construction, Operation and Maintenance of a Gas Distribution System in Millville City.
- Held an executive session for the purpose of discussing land acquisition.

2016 DOG LICENSES

The 2016 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2016. Fees **double** after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$10 each if spayed/neutered and \$20 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$150. Six dogs is the limit! The dog clinic will be held on Saturday, February 6, 2016 from 9am-11am at the City Office building.
