Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In December:

- Jared Steffensen was appointed as an alternate member to the Planning Commission.
- Reviewed the Financial Audit Report for 2011 fiscal year as presented by Mike Kidman of Jones Simkins.
- Awarded bids for leasing of City-owned water shares.
- Adopted the annual meeting schedule for 2012.
- Reviewed a proposal for the north bridge – Millville City assumes maintenance responsibility of the bridge.
- Reviewed information regarding the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance as previously adopted.
- Reviewed information on a mass communication system.
- Set a public hearing for an annexation ordinance as requested by Lance Zollinger et al for parcels 02-089-0021, 03-001-0001, 02-089-0021, 03-001-0002, 03-001-0003. The hearing was scheduled for January 12, 2012 at 7:30 p.m.

NEW YOUTH COUNCIL ADVISORS NEEDED

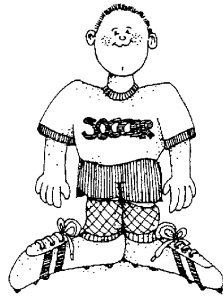

The Logan/Cache Emergency Reverse 9-1-1 notification system has the ability to send mass telephone notifications to the residents of Cache County in the event of an emergency. Emergency notifications can be delivered to your home phone, work phone, or cell phone if an emergency occurs in your area.

Notifications are currently delivered automatically to landline phones for Qwest customers, and to cell phone customers who have completed the registration process on our website.

If you do not have a Qwest phone line register your cell phone(s)! To ensure you receive ALL emergency messages in your area, whether you are home or not, register your cell phone(s)!
