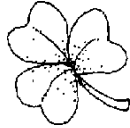

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month.

In February:

- Heard from Savannah Cummings from the Youth Council reporting on the Youth Council's visit to the State Capitol to see our legislature in action.
- Approved a request for the business license for Get Ready Preparedness at 208 North Main as requested by Susan M. Marker.
- Appointed Mark Thacker to serve as a Planning Commissioner and also reappointed Chad Kendrick to serve on the Appeal Authority Board.
- Reviewed the annual First Responder Report for 2010 as presented by David Davenport.
- Discussed fiscal year 2012 budget requests.
- Scheduled Citizen Planner Training to be held on March 3 for the City Council, Planning Commission and the Appeal Authority.
- Reviewed and approved the RAPZ Grant Application to be submitted to the County.
- Reviewed the FEMA Flood Plain Ordinance and set a public hearing for March 10 to receive public input.
- Discussed the new Nibley Substation Project as being constructed by Rocky Mountain Power.

The due date for 2011 Dog Licenses has passed! Fees are now double! Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$7 each if spayed/neutered and \$18 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$120. Six dogs is the limit!
