CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In March:

- Approved a business license for Tammy Jenkins at 590 North 200 East for critical care nursing.
- Held a public hearing on a revision to the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance as proposed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency. This ordinance was approved and replaces 15.16 in the current City Code.
- Mayor Michael Johnson signed a proclamation declaring April, 2011 as Child Abuse Prevention Month. A presentation from the Child and Family Support Center was provided with various fund raising events for the month of April being explained.
- Appointed Kermit Price as the representative for the Mosquito Abatement Board.
- Appointed Pat Bowen to serve on the Planning Commission as a Commissioner.
- Discussed concerns for mail delivery with residents. Approved a letter from the postmaster which is included in this newsletter.
- Appointed Michael Dickman to serve as a Planning Commission Alternate.
- Approved the release of the warranty on the Millville Hills Subdivision as requested by Milton Anderson.
- Canceled the City Council Meeting to be held on April 14, 2011 because of the conflict with training proved by the Utah League of Cities and Towns.
- Reviewed proposed projects with the City Engineer for fiscal years 2012 and 2013.
- Discussed concerns regarding safety at the intersection at 3200 South Highway 165.
- Heard a report on Easter festivities scheduled for April 23rd.
- Discussed Miss Millville which is scheduled on April 30th.
- Reviewed tentative plans for Old Mill Days to be held on June 25th.
- Approved having dumpsters provided at the City Office beginning the weekend of April 21 for the City Spring Cleanup.

Up to three dogs, \$7 each if spayed/neutered and \$18 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$120. Six dogs is the limit!
