

CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month

we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month.

In May:

- Approved a business license for HV Walden Co. at 60 West 400 North as requested by Edward and Terri Walden.
- Reviewed a proposal presented by Quillan Melani to have a flag pole installed at the North Park with lighting.
- Discussed the city-owned trailer located at approximately 450 North Main.
- Revised the fees for dog licenses. New fees are Spayed or Neutered Dogs - \$10; Non-spayed or Non-neutered Dogs - \$20; and Kennel License - \$150.
- Approved the use of a new sign permit application.
- Reviewed with Engineers Zan Murray and Trevor Datwyler a Hydraulic Modeling Study being completed for Millville City.
- Reviewed a revision to the budget for fiscal year 2011 and set a public hearing for June 9, 2011.
- Review the proposed budget for fiscal year 2012 and set a public hearing for June 9, 2011.
- Awarded a road project for crack seal/slurry seal to M&M Asphalt Services.
- Acknowledged from our Miss Millville Pageant that Savannah Cummings, Katie Pehrson, Meagan Williams, and Chelsea Winborg will be representing our City this year.
- Accepted the resignation of Deborah Redman as a City Councilmember effective June 30, 2011. Those interested in filling this vacancy



through the end of the year should submit a 'letter of interest' to: Millville City, ATTN: Rose Mary Jones, PO Box 308, Millville UT 84326. Letters are to be received by June 15 and will be reviewed at the June 23 Council Meeting.

- Heard an update on 'Old Mill Days' to be held June 25.
- Discussed installation of a light in the southeast corner of the City Park.
- Reviewed the annual report on fire services for 2010 as presented by Fire Chief Cardell Nielsen.
- Reviewed Proposals for Audit Services for fiscal year 2011.
- Adopted a Resolution Revising the Terms, Conditions, and Fees for Connecting to the Millville city Municipal Water System, Revising Water Rates, and Specifying Conditions for Security Deposit. This increased the water rate usage from \$.70 to \$.75 per thousand gallons from 0 to 10,000 gallons used and from \$.85 to \$.90 for each thousand used exceeding 10,000 gallons.
- Reviewed a proposed ordinance Establishing a Stormwater Enterprise Fund and set a public hearing for June 9, 2011.
- Reviewed an ordinance to Revise the Energy Sales and Use Tax and set a public hearing for June 9, 2011. This revision would increase the tax from 4% to 6%.
- Reviewed the Millville City Annexation Boundary Plan as adopted in 2002.
- Acknowledged approval of \$25,000 RAPZ grant money which will be used for tables and completion of the new pavilion at the City Park.
- The Water Source Protection Plan submitted to the State of Utah has been accepted for our wells and springs.
- Recognized that Sarah Hardy has been selected to be one of the Cache County Dairy Princesses for this year.

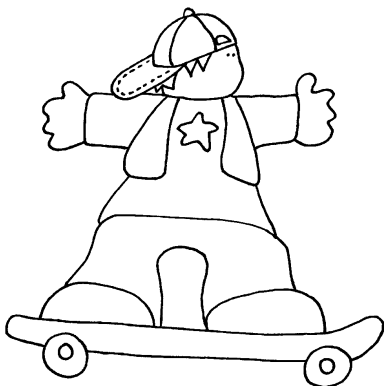
MISS MILLVILLE - 2011
