## CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In May:

- Reviewed proposed revisions to the Zoning Ordinance, Title 17 creating zones of Commercial Service, Commercial Manufacturing, and Commercial Retail along with revising the City Zoning Map as recommended by the Planning Commission. A public hearing was set for June 14, 2012 at 7:30 p.m.
- Reviewed the completed Eagle Scout Project by Marshal Singleton which was to refinish and reinstall the "Welcome to Millville" sign at 100 South 200 West.
- Discussed community goals and services which are available from the Countywide Planning and Development Program.
- Reviewed the Proposed Budget for fiscal year 2012-13 and set a public hearing for June 14, 2012 at 7:30 p.m.
- Reviewed the Revised Budget for fiscal year 2011-12 and set a public hearing for June 14, 2012 at 7:30 p.m.
- Reviewed the crack seal road project which is to be awarded to M&M Asphalt.
- Discussed progress on the old river bridge repair and the river projects.
- Discussed alternate forms for an Appeal Authority as outlined by state law.
- Heard a report from the Cache County Building Department summarizing the activity for the 2011 calendar year.
- Heard a report on the Millville/Nibley Emergency Medical Services for the past year. At the current time, all volunteers participating with this squad are living in Nibley City. They are recruiting individuals wanting to take part in this program from Millville City. Contact the City Office or Councilmember Mark Williams for more information.

The new law allows fireworks to be discharged between July 1 and July 7 for the Fourth of July holiday and between July 21 and July 27 for Pioneer Day. During these times, the discharge times will be from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. — except for on the Fourth of July and Pioneer Day, when the time is extended to midnight.
