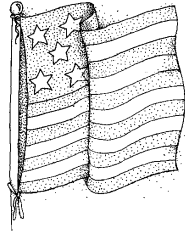


### **CITY COUNCIL CORNER**

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In June



- Discussed the trailer owned by the City at approximately 450 North Main; this will be vacated. The Council approved renting it after repairs were made and using a property management company.
- Approved the Revised Budget for fiscal year 2010-2011.
- Adopted an ordinance to establish a Stormwater Enterprise Fund and set the monthly fee by resolution at \$2 per month per household.
- Approved an ordinance Revising the Energy Sales and Use Tax from 4% to 6%.
- Adopted the budget for fiscal year 2012.
- Approved a resolution setting the salaries for the City Recorder and City Treasurer.
- Approved a 4% salary increase for City employees.
- Discussed audit services; will continue using Jones Simkins PC.
- The Youth Council proposed changes to the dates for serving on this council – from November through October changed to be from July through June. These dates will coincide better with the school year and the fiscal year budget.
- Approved a business license for Chiquira A'More at 7 East Center as requested by Yolanda Vergara.
- Discussed the appointment for the replacement of Councilmember Deborah Redman. Appointed Mark Thacker to be the new Councilmember to fill this six-month vacancy.
- A light on the south end of the park was discussed for installation. This project was put on hold at this time.
- Discussed the election filing period set by state statute from July 1 to 5 p.m. on July 15. There are three four-year term council seats open and one two-year council seat available with terms beginning January, 2012.
