CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In June:

- Approved a business license for Dynamic Communication at 71 West Center as requested by Tobey Fields
- Appointed Jones Simkins to complete the 2012 Audit for the City
- Held a public hearing on the 2012-13 Budget and Certified Tax Rate and Adopted this budget.
- Held a public hearing on revisions to the 2011-12 Budget and adopted the budget
- Approved revisions to the Zoning Ordinance Title 17, Zoning to include zones of Commercial Service, Commercial Manufacturing, and Commercial Retail along with a revision to the City Zoning Map
- Approved a business license for at 45 West 300 South for Three Men and A Shovel Landscaping as requested by Seth Bowen
- Discussed the appointment of the Development Coordinator Position
- Reviewed tentative plans for completing work on the Blacksmith Fork River. A NRCA Grant with a 75/25% match has been accepted by Cache County; they will be spearheading the projects to be completed in Logan City, Millville, Nibley, Providence, and the County. The Millville Project will be primarily to complete debris removal, bank protection, and sediment/erosion control. There will also be a debris basin built with the grant money.
- The City has received a RAPZ Grant for \$30,000 from the Restaurant Tax money as approved by the County for park improvements.

NEW FIREWORKS LAWS

The new law allows fireworks to be discharged between July 1 and July 7 for the Fourth of July holiday and between July 21 and July 27 for Pioneer Day. During these times, the discharge times will be from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. — except for on the Fourth of July and Pioneer Day, when the time is extended to midnight.
