## CITY COUNCIL CORNER

Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In August:

- Approved an Eagle Scout Project to landscape the Old Mill Monument at 200 West 100 South as proposed by Travis Johnson.
- Authorized the trailer at approximately 439 North Main to be sold as Surplus Property.
- Set a public hearing for a revision to the Stormwater Ordinance Title 13.24 of the Millville City Code on September 22, at 7:20 p.m.
- Approved Election Judges for the Municipal Election in November. They are: Lori Iverson, Shanna Zollinger, Lynnette Haltiner, with Jean Parker as alternate; Counting Judges—Jean Parker, Rea Jenkins, Larene Cox, with Margene Stringham as alternate.
- Approved removal of trees on the city right of way at 150 West 200 North.
- Approved an Eagle Scout Project to install barbeque grills near the North Park pavilion as proposed by Nick Chaffin.
- Approved the petition for annexation for real property on the north western boundary of the City as requested by Lance Zollinger. The Council received the Certification of Annexation Petition and Notice to City Council, Contact Sponsor, and Cache County Council as required by State Law from Recorder Rose Mary Jones.
- The Council set the date of November 17 at 7 p.m. for a meeting to Canvass the Election as required by state law.
- Discussed the fate of the north river bridge and possibilities for it.
- Reviewed the service projects that had been completed within the City by various groups recently. There was a light installed at the south end of the City Park, safety chips were installed under the playground equipment at the City Park and North Park, pinecones were

picked up and removed from the City Park, and the trees were trimmed along the roadway on the south and west sides of the school. Thanks to all the volunteers who participated!

## POSTING PLACES FOR INFORMATION

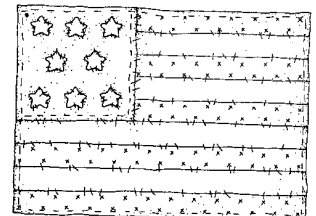

## ARE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE?

If you are not yet registered to vote in Millville City, please go online to [cachecounty.org](http://cachecounty.org) and click on **elections** where you will be



able to complete an online voter registration form. If you choose, you may also register at the County Clerk's Office, 179 North Main, in Logan. The deadline to register is October 24, 2011 if you are planning to vote in the November Municipal Election.

## **MUNICIPAL ELECTION - 2011**

The Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2011 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at the Millville City Offices, 510 East 300 South, Millville Utah. Be sure to bring proper identification with you to vote. The following explains in detail the requirements for identification.

### **Identification Requirements**

#### **In order to vote in Utah, you need valid voter I.D.**

This is either a form of identification that bears the name and photograph of the voter or two forms of identification that bear the name of the voter and provide evidence of the voter's residence,

#### **In Utah, these forms of identification include:**

1. A currently valid Utah driver license;
2. A currently valid ID card issued by the state or a branch, department, or agency of the United States;
3. A currently valid Utah permit to carry a concealed weapon;
4. A currently valid United States passport; or
5. A valid tribal ID card, whether or not the card includes a photograph of the voter.

**Or**

#### **TWO forms of identification that bear the name of the voter and provide evidence that the voter resides in the voting precinct, which may include:**

1. A current utility bill or copy thereof dated within 90 days before the election;
2. A bank or other financial account statement, or legible copy thereof;
3. A certified birth certificate;
4. A valid Social Security card;
5. A check issued by the state or federal government or legible copy thereof;

6. A paycheck from the voter's employer, or legible copy thereof
7. A currently valid Utah hunting or fishing license;
8. A currently valid U.S. military ID card;
9. Certified naturalization documents (NOT a green card);
10. A certified copy of court records showing the voter's adoption or name change;
11. A Bureau of Indian Affairs card;
12. A tribal treaty card;
13. A valid Medicaid or Medicare or Electronic Benefits Transfer card;
14. A currently valid ID card issued by a local government within the state;
15. A currently valid ID card issued by an employer;
16. A currently valid ID card issued by a college, university, technical school or professional school within the state; or
17. A current Utah vehicle registration.
