Each month we will keep you informed of the City Council decisions from the previous month. In November:



- Received and awarded bids on irrigation water share leases for 2011.
- Canceled the City Council Meeting to be held on November 25, 2010 because of the Thanksgiving Holiday.
- Appointed Julianne Duffin to serve as Co-Advisor to the Youth Council along with Deb Low.
- Set a public hearing on December 9, 2010 at 7:15 p.m. to receive public input on: an ordinance Adopting Restrictions on the Manufacture, Distribution, Possession, or Use of Synthetic Cannabinoids; update of the Millville City Zoning Map.
- Reviewed the business licenses issued during the current year and authorized renewals of those businesses for 2011.
- Discussed information pertinent to the storm water and adopted a Resolution for the Storm Water Management Program.
- Reviewed a tentative calendar for City events for 2011; this will be acted upon during the December 9, 2010 Council Meeting.

2011 DOG LICENSES

The 2011 Dog Licenses are here! Remember the deadline for licensing your dog is March 1, 2011. Fees double after that date. Please mail your proof of rabies/proof of spay or neuter along with a payment to Millville City, P.O. Box 308, Millville, UT 84326. Up to three dogs, \$7 each if spayed/neutered and \$18 each if not spayed/neutered. Four to six dogs requires a kennel license fee of \$120. Six dogs is the limit! **This year will be a little different** because the Millville mail slot is gone at the post office. If you mail in your dog license renewal you will have to pick up your tag and paperwork at the Millville City office during regular office hours, Tuesday and Thursday from 10am – 12pm. Please allow two weeks to pick up your tag and paperwork after you send it in. If you have any questions regarding dog licenses please leave a message for Stephanie at 750-0924.
