



# Sidewalk Project

## Project Information

Millville City received two federal grants to install sidewalks in various locations throughout the city.

- ▶ South side of 200 North from 100 West to the Post Office
- ▶ North side of 100 North from 100 West to 225 East
- ▶ North side of 100 South from Main Street to 100 East

**The purpose of this project is to improve pedestrian safety in the area and has been identified as a priority due to increased foot traffic to and from nearby schools.**

## Tentative Schedule

*The following are planned construction activities. Please note that due to weather conditions, emergency situations or equipment/supply issues, schedules are subject to change.*

<b>100 North</b> 100 West to 225 East	<b>September 4 - 11</b> Construction begins. Utility improvements and sidewalk excavation. ## Anticipated Construction Impacts

- ▶ Crews plan to work Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. No weekend work is currently planned.
- ▶ The project team will provide advance notice and coordinate with residents who may be affected by temporary driveway closures to facilitate the work. During driveway closures, residents are asked to park their vehicles on the street on the opposite side of the road.
- ▶ Utility work and sidewalk construction involves heavy construction equipment. To maintain safety in the work zone, residents are asked to avoid the areas that are being worked on and take appropriate safety measures with children.
- ▶ Utility service interruptions are not planned but due to the nature of construction, unplanned service interruptions are possible. The project team will provide advance notice of any planned service interruptions.
